

Health: Improve Health for All Californians

Goal 1: Increased health coverage and care for all low to moderate-income children, families and adults in California

- Outcome 1: Medi-Cal for approximately 170,000 undocumented children will be implemented in an efficient manner so children have timely access to high-quality, comprehensive health and dental coverage and care leading to the best possible health outcomes.
- Outcome 2: Improved access to comprehensive, quality care from the start for pregnant mothers, infants and toddlers to ensure a healthy beginning in life.
- Outcome 3: Outreach, education, enrollment and renewal efforts must be broad, easy to understand, constantly improved and lead to substantial enrollment into and retention of coverage for all of California's diverse populations.
- Outcome 4: Affordable, quality coverage options need to be available to all Californians, regardless of immigration status.

Goal 2: Improve systems to work more effectively across health and human services

- Outcome 5: Integrate, align and streamline eligibility, access and enrollment for health and human services in order to simplify access, maintain benefits during life transitions and comprehensively address families' needs.

Goal 3: Better health through increased preventive care and healthy behavior

- Outcome 6: Prevention funds will be protected and policies will be implemented that advance prevention and wellness in our communities, encourage healthy choices, and take full advantage of opportunities to improve overall consumer and community health.

EDUCATION: Help Children and Youth Achieve Their Potential

Goal 4: Children enter school ready to learn

- Outcome 7: Early learning and school readiness (preschool) opportunities will be available to all children.

Goal 5: Increase percentage of students who graduate ready for higher education or are workforce ready

- Outcome 8: Comprehensive literacy programs will be available to all schools ensuring that students are reading proficiently by 4th grade.
- Outcome 9: Investments will be made in nutritional and physical fitness programs, basic tools, wrap-around services, and mentoring services resulting in a successful transition to middle school.

- Outcome 10: Early warning and intervention systems should be adopted to identify students at risk of dropping out and provide those students with tailored school, family, and community supports.
- Outcome 11: Summer learning opportunities will be available and accessible to all children.

Goal 6: Parent and community engagement in education

- Outcome 12: Provisions of LCFF ensuring parental, student and community engagement will continue to be implemented and research partnerships measuring this will be supported.
- Outcome 13: Every California school district, county office of education, and charter school will have a 3-year Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) that reflects community input and ensures flexibility.

INCOME: Promote Asset Building and Financial Stability

Goal 7: Income supports for working families and individuals

- Outcome 14: Low-income California families and individuals will have the income supports they need to ensure they can get to work, provide the basics for their families and build towards financial stability.
- Outcome 15: Eliminate obstacles and disincentives for low-income people working to improve their futures.

Goal 8: Building assets for long-term financial stability

- Outcome 16: Low-income working families and individuals will have access to targeted financial education, appropriate financial products, and low-cost savings and loan opportunities to help them build financial stability.
- Outcome 17: California will have policies and programs that enable and encourage low-income working individuals and families to save, increase use of long-term investment opportunities, and make saving easy and automatic.

Goal 9: Adequate affordable housing supply for families and individuals

- Outcome 18: California will increase its supply of affordable housing in rural and urban areas for median and low-income individuals, families, seniors and the disabled.

COMMUNITY STRENGTHENING: Build Capacity to Advance the Common Good

Goal 10: All Californians will have access to 2-1-1 services.

- Outcome 19: State legislators and state administrative agencies will understand and embrace the potential for 2-1-1 to help enhance efficiency and streamline delivery of services to strengthen communities.
